C. Fred Sauereisen, 81, died May 14. He was founder and president of the Sauereisen Cements Co.

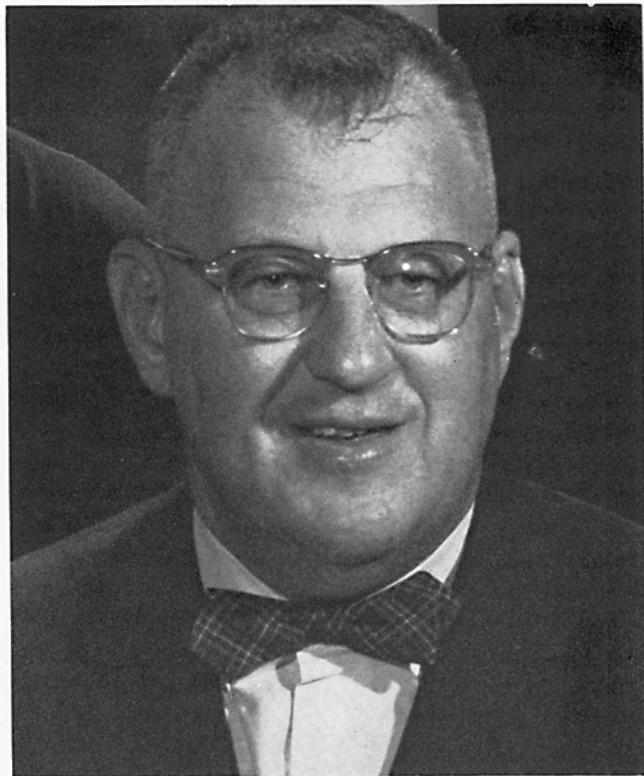
