

AISE Establishes Two Scholarship Grants

TWO new scholarship grants of \$50,000 each have been made by the Association of Iron and Steel Engineers. Both are permanent funds with the income to be used to help needy engineering students.

One of the grants was to the University of Pennsylvania, to be known as the AISE-Morrow fund, in recognition of Linn O. Morrow's service of 50 years as secretary of the Philadelphia district section of AISE.

The second was to Massachusetts Institute of Technology, to be known as the AISE-Madsen fund, in memory of the late I. E. Madsen, who was on the AISE staff for 20 years before his tragic accident last year.

Both funds will be administered by the respective schools.
